101. Stone Cellars Chardonnay, California \$4.50 \$15
Ripe apple, citrus and spice flavors with hints of vanilla.



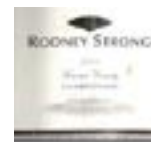
102. Beringer White Zinfandel, California \$4.50 \$15
Summery berry and melon highlights rounded out with subtle flavors of baking spices.



103. Sawtooth Viognier, Idaho \$5.50 \$16
Aromas of pear and apple with hints of honey, minerals and yeast. Creamy finish.



104. Ecco Domani Pinot Grigio, Italy \$6.75 \$20
Fresh apple and spices on the nose. Medium-bodied with light acidity and a mineral, spicy finish.



105. Rodney Strong Chardonnay, Sonoma \$7.00 \$22
Peach and citrus flavors mingled with vanilla and spice aromas.



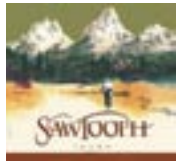
106. Snake River White Riesling, Idaho \$7.50 \$24
This semi-sweet, straw-colored wine has a lingering finish and lemon-drop sweetness balanced by crisp acidity.

107. Barefoot White Zinfandel, California
Tropical aromas combine with ripe fruit flavors that lead to a crisp, clean finish.

Fresh and sweet flavors of apple and pear finishing with lively acidity.

Pinot Noir

Glass / Bottle



201. Mirassou, California \$7.00 \$22
This wonderful pinot displays intense flavors of strawberry, pomegranate and cherry.



202. Lindemans, Australia \$15
Light and pleasant, with cooked plum and currant, finishing with a polished texture.



203. Red Bicyclette, France \$22
Bright cherry flavors followed by soft and lush tannins in a smooth textured wine.



204. Irony, Monterey \$28
Berry flavors with mild spices and hints of roasted nuts and vanilla oak. Medium bodied with mild, earthy tannins.

Cabernet Sauvignon



301. Black Swan, Australia \$4.50 \$15
Balanced aromas of strawberries and chocolate and just a hint of eucalyptus.



302. Red Diamond, Washington \$6.00 \$18
Truffle, blackberry liqueur and tobacco aromas precede a silky velvet-textured palate of ripe black fruits and chocolate.

Cabernet Sauvignon (Cont.)



303. Wolf-Blass, Australia *Glass / Bottle* \$7.50 \$23
Soft and generous, with red cherry and black currant flavors.



304. Redwood Creek Cabernet, Modesto \$15
A Dark, rich medley of raspberry, blueberry and boysenberry combined with notes of vanilla oak complemented by a smooth, velvety finish.



305. Sagelands, Washington \$22
Balanced tannins and larger than life berry flavor. Anise aromas with hints of vanilla and blackberry. Dark cherry and chocolate in the finish.

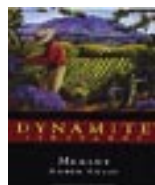
Merlot



401. Stone Cellars, California \$4.50 \$15
Well-balanced with ripe strawberry and red cherry flavors, a soft-mid palate and finishing with a hint of baking spice.



402. Redwood Creek Merlot, Modesto \$5.00 \$16
Herbaceous nose precedes a balanced palate of plum, cherry and chocolate flavors. Smooth tannins make for a pleasant mouth feel.



403. Dynamite, Sonoma \$6.50 \$19
Aromas of black cherry, blueberry, currant and toast. Flavors of dark fruits and cherries are accompanied by hints of dark chocolate and vanilla. Light, ripe tannins and a long finish.

Merlot (Cont.)

Glass / Bottle



404. Rodney Strong, Sonoma \$29
Plum and blueberry flavors are dominant in this rich, mouth filling merlot. Aging in oak barrels has imparted a toasty vanilla flavor before its creamy berry finish.

Syrah, Shiraz & Petite Sirah



501. Fat Bastard Shiraz, France \$7.50 \$23
Deep crimson red in color. Berries, red fruit and spicy notes on the nose. Typically spicy shiraz aromas.



502. Rosemont Shiraz, Australia \$19
Ripe, rich, and intense, packed with a solid core of plum and black cherry flavors.



503. Bogle Petite Syrah, California \$24
Spicy, earthy notes add a little extra to the soft plum and berry flavors that linger through the finish.



504. Sawtooth Syrah, Idaho \$28
Aromas of plum, raspberry, strawberry and creamy spices precede rich fruit flavors.

Other Red Wines

Glass / Bottle



601. *Trapiche Malbec, Argentina* \$6.50 \$19
Plum and cherry in the nose. In the mouth the fruit is round and supple, with a note of truffle and vanilla.



602. *Gnarley Head Old Vine Zin, CA*..... \$7.00 \$22
Crafted from grapes from 35-80 year-old vines. Rich, dark berry flavors enhanced with layers of plum, pepper and chocolate.



603. *Cella Lambrusco, Italy* \$14
Delicious fleshy body, well balanced in acidity and slightly fruity with dark cherry and strawberry flavors.



604. *Tapeña Tempranillo, Spain* \$18
A rich and bold blend of fruit, earth and structure rounded out by a deliciously soft mouth feel



605. *Gabbiano Chianti, Tuscany* \$19
The first sip reveals invigorating flavors of sour cherry, blackberry, and spice followed by a dry vivid finish.



606. *Don Miguel Gascon Malbec, Argentina* \$28
Perfumed nose of cedar, spice, and black cherry. Forward, smooth-textured, and savory on the palate. Lingering, juicy finish.



607. *Cline "Ancient Vines" Zinfandel, Sonoma* \$29
Wonderful dusty raspberry, blackberry, white pepper and spice flavor with coffee and chocolate characters.
